First Meeting

Four Named to USL Championship "Team of the Week"

Indy Eleven defenders Logan Neidlinger and Aodhan Quinn, forward Bruno Rendon, and Coach Sean McAuley have been selected to the USL Championship "Team of the Week" after helping the Boys in Blue extend their USL-C home unbeaten streak to seven with a 2-1 victory over Sporting JAX on Saturday at Carroll Stadium.

The 20-year-old Neidlinger earned "Team of the Week" honors for the first time in his career. The youngest non-Academy player on the Boys in Blue roster set up the game-winning goal in the 65th minute by fellow defender Anthony Herbert with a laser from 30 yards out that struck the crossbar near the right post, with Herbert heading the rebound home.

The Indy Eleven Academy product recorded two shots in the match, winning 8 of 11 duels and adding eight recoveries and four clearances in his third consecutive start. The Indiana native became the youngest player (age 18) to score a goal for the Boys in Blue on 8/11/24 vs. New Mexico United.

Quinn earned "Team of the Week" accolades for the second time this season after recording his 62nd career assist in USL-C play (second on the league all-time list). With his team trailing in the 51st minute, Quinn played a corner from the left side that Rendon headed between goalkeeper Christian Olivares' arms for his team-high fourth goal in eight USL-C games this season and his fifth in all competitions. In the match, Quinn had six chances created while winning seven of eight ground duels.

Quinn is the USL-C all-time leader in minutes (24,888) and games started (284), and he is second in assists (62) and appearances (298). In 2026 league stats, Quinn is second in chances created (20), tied for seventh in blocks (7), and eighth in crosses (45).

Rendon surpassed his 2025 goal total of three with his fourth in

USL-C play and fifth overall. The 26-year-old Rendon is tied for ninth in the league in shots on target (10) and duels won (54), tied for 10th in goals (4), 11th in aerial duels won (31), tied for 14th in chances created (13), and tied for 17th in shots (14).

Rendon became the first player in the three-year history of the USL Cup to reach double digits in goals with his 10th vs. Union Omaha on April 25 at Carroll Stadium.

McAuley's side posted season bests in shots (26), shots on target (9), corner kicks (12), and possession (54.2%) vs. Sporting JAX.

Indy Eleven has had six different players earn USL-C "Team of the Week" this season.

Boys in Blue Extend USL-C Home Unbeaten Streak to Seven

Indy Eleven used two second-half goals to rally from a halftime deficit to extend their USL Championship home unbeaten streak to seven (6-0-1) dating back to last season with a 2-1 win over Sporting JAX at Carroll Stadium on Saturday.

Defender Anthony Herbert recorded his first Boys in Blue goal in the 65th minute for the game-winner. Defender Logan Neidlinger set it up with a laser from 30 yards out that struck the crossbar near the right post. The ball caromed high into the air, with Herbert positioning his 6'4 frame just outside the six. He headed it down and it bounced into the right corner of the net.

Indy Eleven trailed 1-0 in the 51st minute when captain Aodhan Quinn took a corner from the left side. Forward Bruno Rendon headed it between goalkeeper Christian Olivares' arms for his team-high fourth goal in eight USL-C games this season and his fifth in all competitions. Quinn recorded his 62nd career assist, good for second on the league all-time list.

The Boys in Blue have earned five points from losing positions this season, the third-best in the league.

Coach Sean McAuley

Sean McAuley earned USLC "Coach of the Month" in May 2024 and was nominated for USLC Midseason "Coach of the Year" after leading his team to a 12-match unbeaten streak (4/17-6/15).

The Sheffield, England, native led Indy Eleven to the 2024 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup semifinals with four straight victories, including a 2-1 triumph at MLS-side Atlanta United on July 9.

In 2025, Indy Eleven continued its run of Cup success under McAuley with a 4-0-3 record in cup play. The Boys in Blue won their U.S. Open Cup Third Round match vs. Miami FC on Hayden's White's stoppage-time goal from Cam Lindley. In the Round of 32, Indy Eleven played MLS Supporters Shield winner Philadelphia Union to a 1-1 draw through 120 minutes, before falling in penalty kicks.

In the franchise's first appearance in the USL Cup in 2025, the Boys in Blue won their group with an undefeated record that included a victory in PK's (7-6) vs. Birmingham Legion FC and a 2-1 triumph over eventual USL-C finalist FC Tulsa.

McAuley is in his third season in Indy after serving as interim head coach/assistant at MLS-side Minnesota United FC. McAuley helped Minnesota to playoff appearances in his first three seasons, including a trip to the 2020 Western Conference Finals.

In 2015, he hoisted the MLS Cup with the Portland Timbers. McAuley began his playing career with Manchester United and played for Portland Timbers and the Scottish U-21 National Team.

COACHING STAFF



SEAN McAULEY | HEAD COACH | 3RD YEAR

Sean McAuley began his Indy Eleven tenure in impressive fashion in 2024, leading the Boys in Blue to a franchise-best 12-match unbeaten streak from April 17-June 15, including a club-best eight consecutive wins in USL Championship action. The eight-match winning streak is tied for the fifth-longest in the USL-C. Indy is one of only seven teams in USL Championship history to win eight straight matches in league play. The Boys in Blue outscored their opponents 16-5 in those eight matches, while posting six clean sheets and never conceding more than one goal.

McAuley was named the USL Championship Coach of the Month for May. During that month, the Boys in Blue went 4-0-0 in USL-C action. Indy outscored its opponents 10-3 over the four matches, including scoring three-plus on twice. During the month, six Boys in Blue players earn USL Championship Team of the Week honors or bench honors, while Aedan Stanley was named the Player of the Week for Week 10.

The USL Midseason "Coach of the Year" nominee guided his squad on an unprecedented run to the semifinals of the 2024 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup with four consecutive victories, including a 2-1 triumph at MLS-side Atlanta United (the franchise's first win vs. an MLS team). The Boys in Blue's run marked the 15th time that a lower division team reached the semifinals since MLS joined the competition in 1996.

McAuley's squad earned the franchise's first home playoff game since 2019 by finishing fourth in the Eastern Conference with a 14-11-9 mark. The 14 victories and 51 points are the second-best in team USL-C history.

The Boys in Blue set a new USLC franchise-record with 49 goals in regular-season play. Indy Eleven scored in 15 straight matches to open the campaign, the longest ever to start a USL-C season and the best in team history in a single campaign.

In 2025, Indy Eleven continued its run of Cup success under McAuley with a 4-0-3 record in cup play. The Boys in Blue won their U.S. Open Cup Third Round match vs. Miami FC on Hayden's White's stoppage-time goal from Cam Lindley. In the Round of 32, Indy Eleven played MLS Supporters Shield winner Philadelphia Union to a 1-1 draw through 120 minutes, before falling in penalty kicks.

In the franchise's first appearance in the USL Cup, the Boys in Blue won their group with an undefeated record that included a victory in PK's (7-6) vs. Birmingham Legion FC and a 2-1 triumph over eventual USL-C finalist FC Tulsa.



PHIL PRESSER | FIRST ASSISTANT & RECRUITING COORDINATOR | 8TH YEAR

Phil Presser's focus is on offensive organization and player recruitment. In 2019, he helped Indy to USLC franchise records of 19 wins and 63 points in the regular season and two playoff wins to reach the Eastern Conference Finals. He began as Sporting Director, Academy Operations in 2022. The Academy Director and Technical Director created the first official pathway in state history from youth academy to the Indy Eleven First Team in 2019. Since then, 30 players have signed USL Academy contracts, with seven of them going on to sign pro contracts. Current Boys in Blue Cam Lindley and Logan Neidlinger are two members of this elite group.



JASON PERRY | ASSISTANT COACH | 1ST YEAR

Jason Perry is in his first year as an Assistant Coach. The Southfield, Michigan, native comes to the First Team after coaching in the Indy Eleven Academy, working with all MLS NEXT Pro teams in Homegrown and Academy Divisions. At Butler University, Perry was an Assistant Coach and Recruiting Coordinator from 2012-23, helping the Bulldogs to 97 victories and playing a large role in transitioning Butler's program from the Horizon League to the Atlantic 10 and the BIG EAST. Perry played professionally with three different teams from 2004-07. He was selected in the fifth round of the 2004 MLS SuperDraft by the Los Angeles Galaxy, after participating in the MLS Combine.



ANDY SWIFT | DIRECTOR, GOALKEEPING & VIDEO ANALYST | 9TH YEAR

Goalkeeper Coach & Video Analyst Andy Swift returns for his ninth season with Indy Eleven. He is responsible for goalkeepers, opposition scouting, and defensive set pieces. With Indy Eleven, Swift has helped coach the Boys in Blue to the 2024 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup semi-finals and four USL Championship playoff appearances, including the 2019 Eastern Conference finals. Swift is also a Goalkeeper Coach for the Indy Eleven W League team and the Director of Goalkeeping for the Indy Eleven Academy. Swift has earned the US Soccer Federation A-Senior License, Goalkeeping License, and the United Soccer Coaches National Goalkeeping Diploma and Advanced National Diploma.
